

GATE CODE

Addition to Rules and Regulations on October 17, 2005

The Gate Code is used to help protect everyone's boats, trailers, belongings and Club property. The code is for use of **MEMBERS ONLY**. This code should **NOT** be given out to children, friends, neighbors, fishing buddies, work associates, brothers, sisters or anyone who is not a member of Buckeye Boat Club.

If you are sponsoring a large event on Club property or in the Clubhouse you can be given a one (1) day code for all of your guests to use to enter the property. Contact the Rear Commodore in advance of your function for that special code. Please do **NOT** post that special code outside the gate for the general public to see. Remember this is for all members protection.

Outside vendors, such as boat dealer who enters the Club grounds from time to time to service our members needs, can be issued a special code for only his use. The vendor should contact the Rear Commodore to receive this vendor code. Only this vendor or his employee should ever use this code and then only for business purposes.

NEVER GIVE THE GATE CODE TO A NON-MEMBER

IF A VIOLATION HAPPENS:

- (1) The Gate Code will be changed as soon as possible.
- (2) A change notice will have to be sent to every member.
- (3) The offending members name will be published.
- (4) The offending member will receive a penalty:
 - (A) At a minimum, pay the cost of printing/ mailing/ postage of the membership notification (approx \$90)
 - (B) At a maximum, the possible loss of membership.
